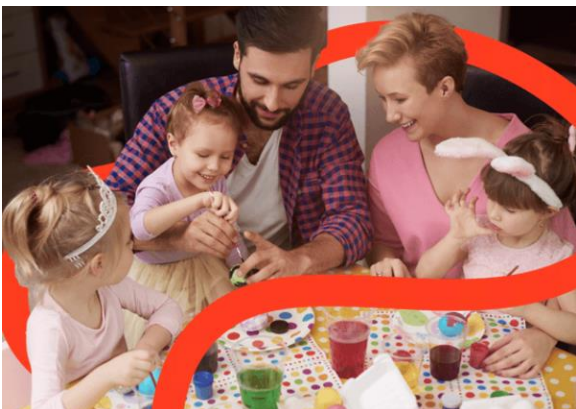
GIVE THANKS

- The promise of the Spirit's presence and guidance in our daily work and lives, that helps us to listen and be aware, to channel all we are given into positive outcomes for children and families.

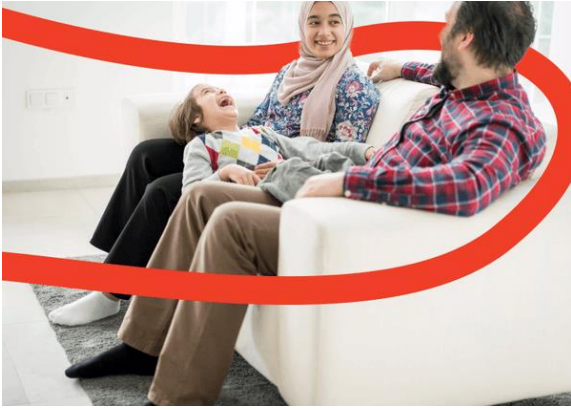
CHILDREN AND FAMILIES
