We work through children and family centres, churches, schools and prisons, putting children first in everything.

Family Support

Spurgeons works with families offering activities and support to help children get the best start.

We provide support across communities in our family and children's centres, family hubs and counselling for children and teenagers.

Information, advice and access to children's health services are offered alongside 1-1 support, groups and drop-in sessions.



Counselling

Spurgeons offers support for children, young people, parents and carers through one-toone counselling either face-to-face or remotely with BACP registered counsellors.

Counselling can involve talking about and exploring, with art, play, sand tray work, role play or games the client's feelings, thoughts and experiences

Early Years Health and Wellbeing

Spurgeons supports all families to live safe, happy, healthy lifestyles. We offer sessions for under 5s and groups for new parents and babies, as well as more specialist support. We provide activities for children and young people at various locations across the country, to help parents and families build a strong foundation for their child's future. Families are welcome at our dad's group, parenting courses or in our sensory rooms.



Preschool

Spurgeons preschools offer a friendly, caring and stimulating preschool environment for children to grow. We prioritise high quality play equipment, for both inside and outside play, and support the whole family with onsite counselling and family support.

Prisoner Family Support

Through parenting courses, family days, baby bonding sessions, and homework clubs, we strengthen the bond between imprisoned parents and their children. We collaborate with specialist organisations addressing substance abuse, domestic violence and mental health, working closely with children's services, probation services and trained counsellors. Our comprehensive support allows us to extend our assistance beyond the gates after their release.



Our Impact in 2024

- of children say they made progress when being supported by our 100% services.
- of families said they made progress across their lives when working 97% with us.
- of children have made headway with their feelings and behaviour. 86%
- people reached digitally through our courses, social media and online **2M** content.
- We are currently working intensively with 220 prisoners to improve 220 relationships with their families and children.
- were safeguarded and kept safe from domestic abuse, neglect and **694** the effects of poor mental health.



Domestic Abuse Care and Recovery

We provide support and evidence-informed interventions for children and adults affected by domestic abuse and training for professionals.

Parenting Advice and Support

Spurgeons develops good relationships between parents and their children. We can help parents understand the causes of behaviour and identify where things are not working. We also offer additional support for families and children with Special Educational Needs. Positive parenting can lead to happier children with higher chances of good mental health and a long-lasting positive effect on future generations.
